announces a call for tuition fee reduction
in the 2021/2022 academic year for

MASTER STUDIES IN THE FOLLOWING POSTGRADUATE STUDY PROGRAMMES:

- 1. NANOSCIENCES AND NANOTECHNOLOGIES**
- 2. INFORMATION AND COMMUNICATION TECHNOLOGIES**
- 3. ECOTECHNOLOGIES**

Tuition fee reduction:

For the selected candidates, the tuition fee shall be reduced for 1 year of master studies for the 2021/2022 academic year.

Selection criteria:

- Average grade from completed 1st-cycle studies, or the average grade from the 1st year of studies at the IPS for candidates who have regularly advanced to the 2nd year, of at least 8.00 – the number of points equals the average grade (up to 10 points),
- Proposed supervisor's opinion with the assessment of achievements presented in the candidate's motivation letter that was submitted in the application for enrolment (up to 10 points).

Explanatory note:

- For candidates who completed their 1st-cycle studies outside of Slovenia, conversion of their average grade from abroad shall be considered according to the percentage scale from the official document of the university following the formula: converted average grade = average percentage score / 10,
- If the percentage scale cannot be determined, the average grade shall be converted by the Committee for the Recognition of Education.

The IPS Study Commission shall forward the proposal for approving a maximum of 10 tuition fee reductions to the IPS Senate for the final decision.

Applications for tuition fee reduction:

The application for fee reduction shall be submitted together with the application for enrolment to info@mps.si by 30 September 2021 at the latest.

The application shall contain:

- Certificate with the average grade from the completed 1st-cycle studies,
- Proposed supervisor's opinion with the assessment of achievements presented in the candidate's motivation letter that was submitted in the application for enrolment.
